## FINANCE NEWS

We would like to advise all families who are unaware of the new government \$150 donation scheme that our school opted in to.

For many families who pay regular Automatic Payments to their student/s accounts you may like to re-consider either stopping or reducing the amount of these payments if the account is fully paid already. As there are no course material or workbook costs payable your account may be accumulating a large credit balance.

However, if your student is taking a technology course where there is a take home component and they choose to do so you may wish to leave some credit funds in the account. Likewise, if they have any future events i.e. tournament week, school ball, year 13 leaver's items.
